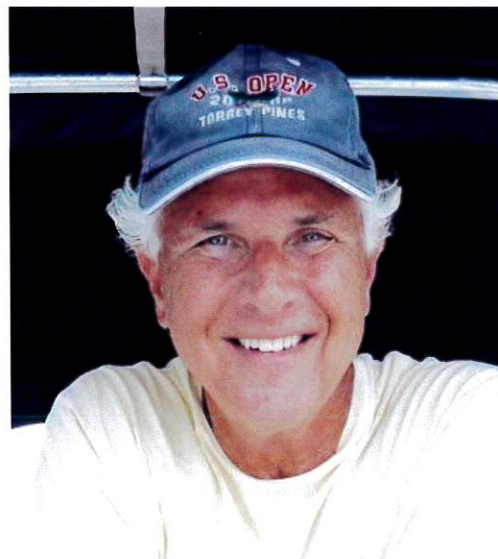

WHAT TO EXPECT...

Our Senior Adult Bible School begins at 10am each morning with gathering and social time, then the content session from 10:30 to noon. Each session of biblical story-telling, teaching, music and worship ends with a light lunch served at 12.

Participants will receive a booklet of all the Gospel stories Ed will reference, including the Bible texts and songs he’ll use.
